

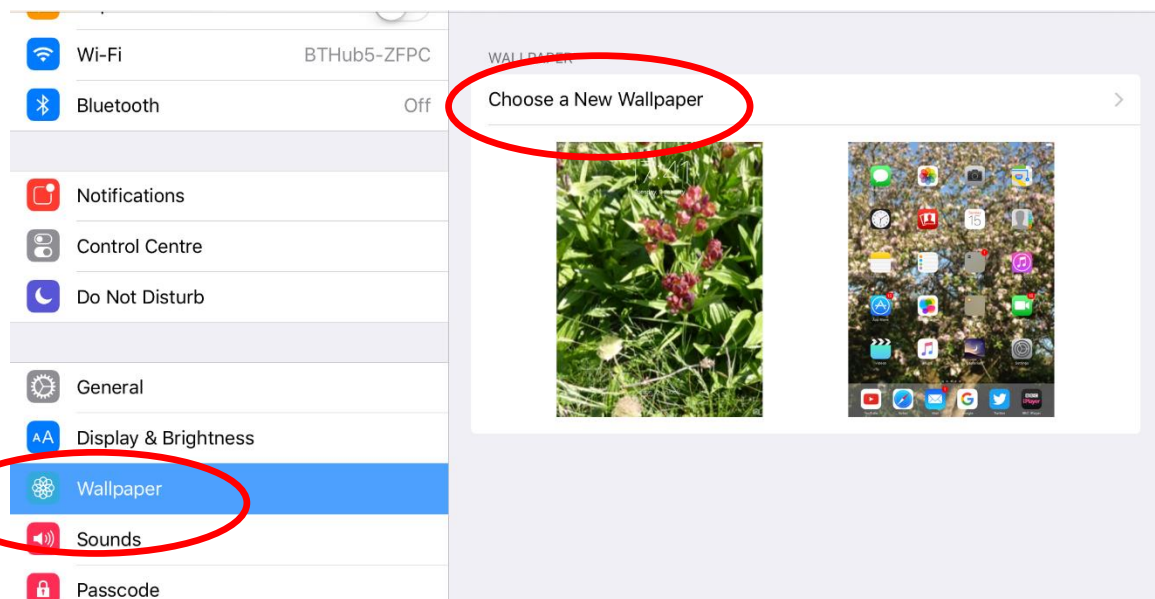
TASK CARD 9: how to change your wallpaper!

iPad

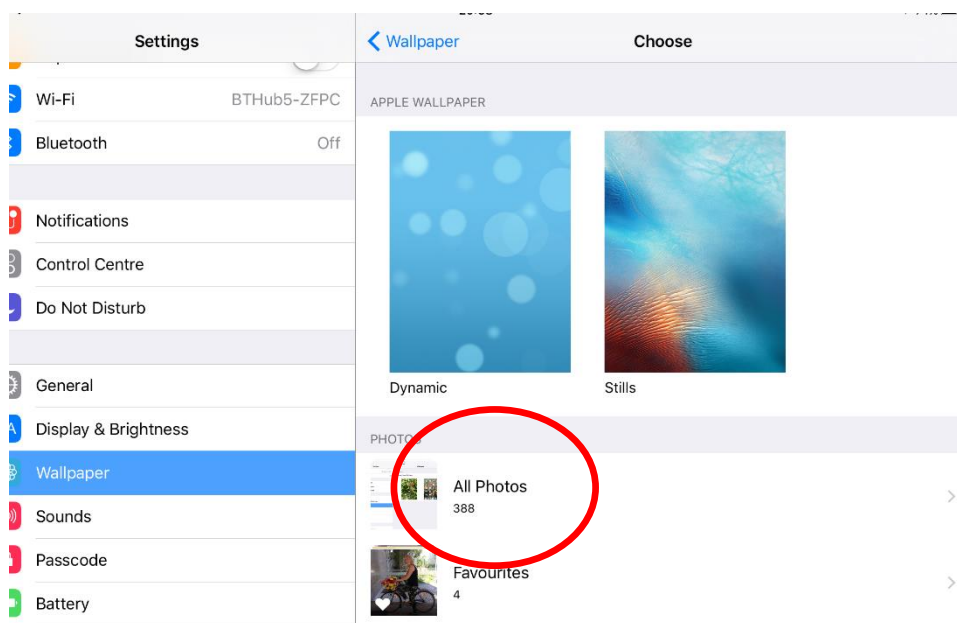
This card shows you how to personalize the appearance of your home and lock screens with your own choice of photos. Lock screen is the screen you see when you first switch on your iPad ie before you put in the Passcode.

The image that displays on the lock screen and in the background on your Home screen is called the wallpaper. Here you learn how to change it.

- 1 First tap “Settings” icon and tap “Wallpaper” on the left. The Wallpaper screen now appears with your current choices on the right. Tap “Choose a New Wallpaper”



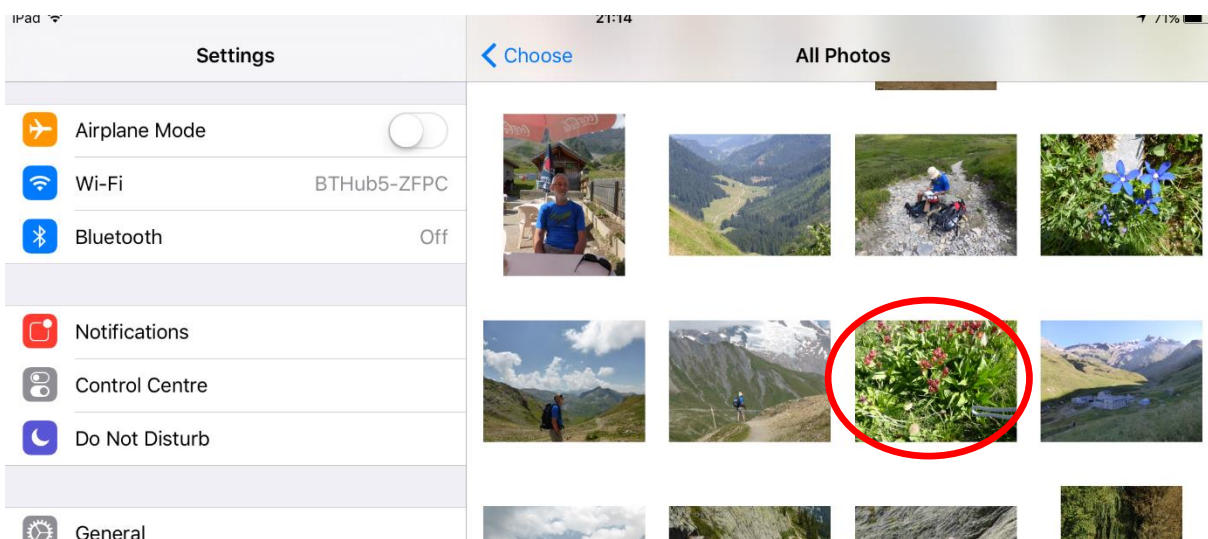
- 2 You now have a choice of Dynamic (repeating movie) or Stills (photo) provided by Apple or of using one of your own photos. Tap on “All Photos” as on screen below.

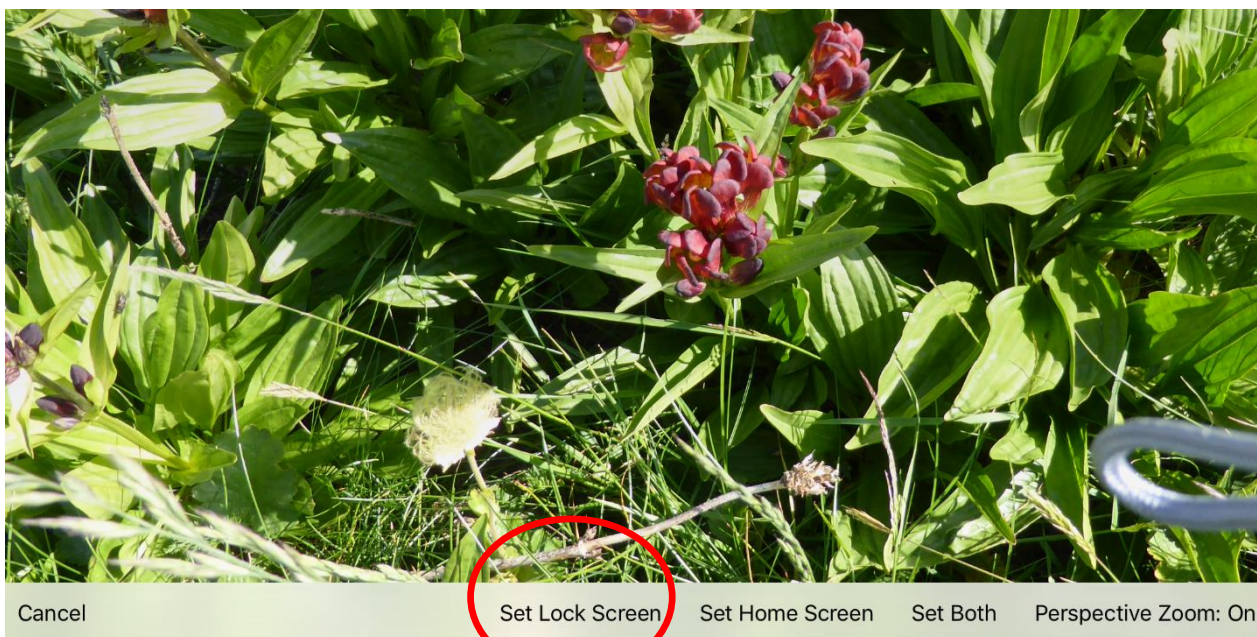
On the screen below, tap on the photo of your choice.

Now you can choose “Set Lock Screen” or “Set Home Screen” (the one with the icons on) or choose “Set Both” meaning make both the same. Tap “Set Lock Screen”.



Now turn the iPad off and on and you should see your photo come up.

Try go through the whole process again trying some other choices. For example you could try to set up one of the Dynamic images provided by Apple on your Home Screen. Happy wallpapering!
